### What to Bring With You

You **MUST** bring these to build:

1. Complete/Signed Volunteer Liability Release Form  
Under 18 use Form for Minors signed by parent  
18 and over use Standard Form
2. Emergency Contact Name & Telephone Number
3. One OR more items from attached list:  
November & December Volunteers - Consumable Household Supplies  
January Volunteers & February 2<sup>nd</sup> Volunteers- "Extreme Sweets" or \$1  
February 9<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> and March Volunteers - Building Supplies

**Good items to bring:**

Community Service Hour Forms for signature.

Fun money (\$2 or so for candy, misc.)

Small day pack, Chap Stick, poncho, hat, gloves/mittens, cell phone.

Work gloves, hammer, & tool belt (not required; Habitat provides).

## What to Wear

Wear old clothes. Dress in layers; temperatures change during the day. **Good Footwear in Most Important!** Wear work boots, hard soled shoes, or suitable footwear for working at construction sites. Flip-flops and open-toed shoes are not permitted.

## Cancellation for Bad Weather

We frequently build on inclement weather days. We often work indoors on "ugly" days. Construction is cancelled when conditions are hazardous for workers. **Youth Group Leaders will be contacted if construction is cancelled.** Please check with your Youth Group Leader first. **Alternatively, you may call 214-334-7120 OR 469-438-8581 OR 972-979-9517 to check status.**

## Meals

We furnish continental breakfast and lunch for AM and Full Day volunteers. Snacks, water, and beverages are available all day. There is no charge for food or beverage. Candy is available for sale. Individuals with special dietary needs should bring a lunch.
